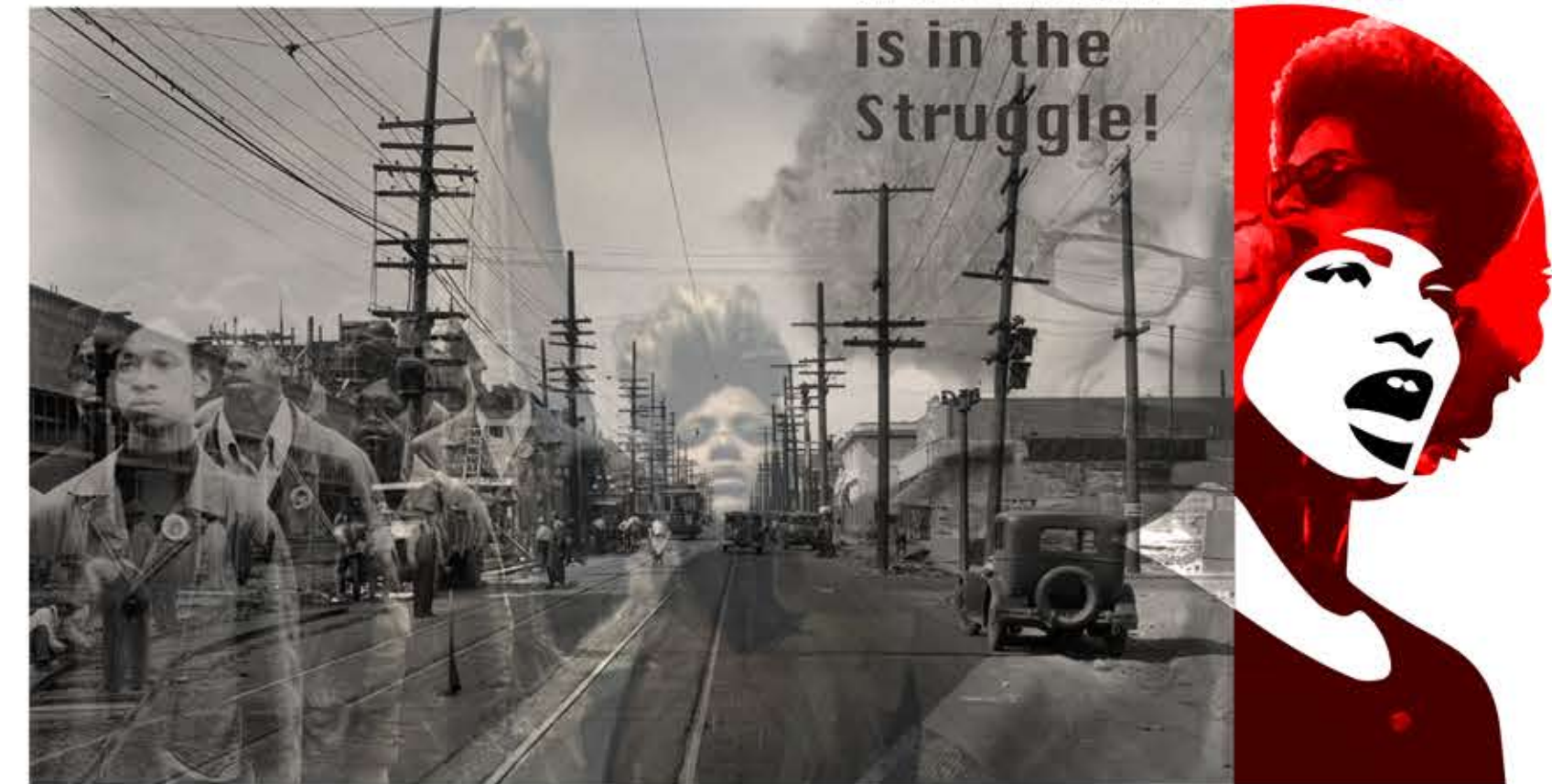

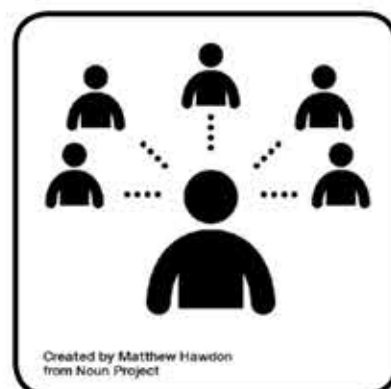

Storefronts focused on black culture and history run by residents of the community bring back celebrated culture to share with and support the community; mixed-use housing provides a convenient live-work environment to cut down on commute times and transportation costs.



Lecture and classroom space for engaging students and the community with black professionals on a local, national, and global level.



Community services including daycare, social services, and a community garden provide an extra level of care for people using the educational and employment resources of the center.



Athletic and recreation facilities provide youth with extracurricular activities and places for community engagement. The facilities can accommodate a wide range of both pick-up and organized sports and provide all members of the community with a place to come together. Teaching and coaching opportunities for sports are created as well as foundations for youth and/or adult leagues. Small studios provide space for dance and yoga to further promote healthy living.
